



Charles King Lee Memorial Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies 2008-2009

The 'Charles King Lee Memorial Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies' was established in September 1996 by Mr. Anthony H.N.Lee, a Wahyanite who graduated in 1964, as a memory to his father, the late Mr. Charles King Lee. This Scholarship aims to providing financial assistance to those promising Wah Yan student(s) who has/have good service records but is/are of financial need to pursue to university studies locally. The scholarship will be for a maximum of three years and is renewable annually and is dependent on the applicant's family financial condition and his academic progress. The Administration Board of Charles King Lee Memorial Scholarship will judge this. It is intended to relieve students of as much financial anxiety throughout their three years of local university education as possible. It is also intended to free them from taking odd-jobs and allowing them to concentrate on their studies.

Further details of the scholarship are as follows:-

- Name of Award : Charles King Lee Memorial Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies
- Duration of Award : Maximum up to 3 years renewable annually in the light of family financial conditions and academic progress. The Administration Board of Charles King Lee Memorial Scholarship will judge this.
- Value of Award : The amount of award for each successful applicant will be \$10,000 per year to a maximum of 3 years.
- Conditions of Award : Successful candidates for the scholarships will be required to comply with the conditions of awards should they decide to accept any award made under this scheme. In particular, these candidates must return to work in Hong Kong or other areas in China, or obtain employment with any entity or organization in Hong Kong, for a minimum of 36 consecutive months immediately on completion of their study programme. Permission for a delayed return to Hong Kong to fulfill the employment condition for waiver of such employment condition may be sought from the Administration Board of the scholarship who will consider the merit of the candidate's case. If the candidate fails to get such permission or to comply with the employment condition, he will be required to repay such sum, not exceeding the total value of the award so received, and upon such terms as the Administration Board deems appropriate.
- Eligibility : Applicants for the scholarship must fulfil the following criteria:-
- (i) be permanent residents of Hong Kong.
 - (ii) have received at least 3 years of continuous education in Wah Yan College, Hong Kong.
 - (iii) Be offered a place in any of the local tertiary institution to pursued a degree course study.
 - (iv) be in genuine need of financial assistance. Where, for example, the family can only make some but not a full contribution to the student's further studies.
- should be keen to contribute to the society of Hong Kong upon their graduation.

- Application** : Application forms will be available from February each year.
All applications, including those applying for renewal, should reach the Principal of Wah Yan College, Hong Kong on or before mid-August each year.
