**Admission Policy 2010-2011**

Thank you for your interest in the College, and we welcome your application to Wah Yan College, Hong Kong. As an aided-school, admission to Form One (2010-2011) in Wah Yan is regulated by the SSPA system. Students of Form One are admitted either through the discretionary placing system or allocated through the central allocation system. Our Feeder School is Pun U Association Wah Yan Primary School.

**Application details for admission to Form One (2010-2011)**

1. Dates to submit application:  
4<sup>th</sup> January, 2010 – 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2010 (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday)
2. Number of Form One classes: 4  
Number of Discretionary Places: 43
3. Students from Pun U Association Wah Yan Primary School should follow instructions given by the primary school authority.
4. Parents of students from other primary schools can obtain the application forms either in person during school office hours (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday), or by post together with a stamped self-addressed envelope or by downloading the form from the school web-site.
5. The completed application form together with the required documents, must be submitted to our College **by hand** on or before 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2010. Recommendation letter(s) from primary schools should **NOT** be submitted with the application.
6. Based on the academic performance, all-round development and position in Discretionary Places Rank Order List, a number of selected applicants will be invited for an interview in late March 2010. The College will issue a letter of invitation in mid March 2010.
7. Admission criteria and weighting:

	<u>Weighting</u>
a) Academic performance and all-round development	30%
b) Position in Discretionary Places Rank Order List	20%
c) Interview performance	50%

**Admission to Form Two, Three or Four (2010-11)**

1. Application letters should be sent to the Principal with all relevant documents and a stamped self-addressed return envelope in late May or early June 2010.
2. If vacancies are available, suitable candidates will be invited for written test in English, Chinese and Mathematics on 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2010 and an interview on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2010.

**Admission to Form Six (2010-11)**

The College strictly follows the Secondary Six Admission Procedure set by the Education Bureau of the HKSAR.

**Admission to Form Five and Seven (2010-11)**

Application for admission to Form 5 or Form Seven will not be considered.
