1. What are the details of AEMSS - The Summer Exchange programme?

- **2. What are the objectives of the programme?** The programme aims to help participants develop confidence and skills in English communication.
- 3. What will the students gain from the programme? Students will learn to use English with confidence at public events. They will learn to deliver a speech in English and basic debating skills. They will learn about the culture of Harvard University, gain a better understanding of American culture in general and make friends with outstanding scholars. They will discover their potential in leadership and fall in love with English!
- **4. How will the students be grouped?** Students will be grouped according to their English proficiency level.
- 5. Who designs the curriculum? The curriculum, designed for students aged 10-18, is designed by students at the Harvard Graduate School of Education. It is a flexible and innovative curriculum. The fee covers all course materials as well as outings and visits.
- **6.** What are the hours? Class hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. each day with one hour lunch break from noon to 1:00 p.m. There will be activities, outings and visits after the classes so that students can continue to communicate and practise their English in social situations.
- 7. When will the interviews be held? Students will be initially interviewed over the phone. Then, they will be invited to attend a group interview by Harvard alumni at Kiangsu-Chekiang College (Shatin) on the afternoon of June 6, 2009.
- 8. What is the application procedure? Students should download or photocopy the application form from either www.csef.org.cn or kcc-st.school.net.hk. The completed forms should be endorsed by the school principal and then sent, in bulk, to Kiangsu-Chekiang College (Shatin) at 7 Fung Shun Street, Wo Che Estate, Shatin, N.T. on/before May 31, 2009.
- 9. How should payment be made? After the group interview on June 6, 2009, applicants should submit the fees to their school so that the school can send a cheque payable to "Association of English Medium Secondary Schools" to Mr. Chan Hon Ling, principal of Kiangsu-Chekiang College (Shatin) by mail. Schools should send their cheques on/before June 19, 2009.
- 10. Where is Kiangsu-Chekiang College (Shatin)? The school is at 7 Fung Shun Street, Wo Che Estate, Shatin. This Band 1 EMI secondary school is easily accessible by bus. The school was Champion of the Green School Award in Hong Kong. All classrooms are air-conditioned and well-equipped.
