- A: Determination of applicants' suitability for admission is entirely the decisions of the 9 participating-institutions and is entirely independent of the JUPAS Office. Applicants should refer to the general entrance requirements and individual programme requirements for more information.

Conditional Offer based on OEA

- You may be given conditional offer(s) based on the OEA information you have submitted!
- You can view the feedback on 10 July 2015 (from 9:00 am) by logging in onto your JUPAS account to check the results
- You will be notified by the JUPAS Office and you will be required to submit the certified true copies of relevant supporting documents to the JUPAS Office during the period 10 – 18 July 2015 (by 5:00 pm)

Other **Possible** Uses of OEA in Jupas

- Some OEA items may be counted in the point calculation of assignment of Jupas place
- Some OEA items may be critical in distinguishing two applicants with equal point
- Some OEA items may initiate granting an interview for you
- OEA and "additional information" may provide the content which the interviewer will ask you

- Be coherent with your "additional information"!

- It is a must to type explanation for clarification in "description" for self-entered items




- JUPAS system will randomly select and request for the supporting document(s) for OEA item(s)














Deadlines
