

New Senior Secondary (NSS) Curriculum

- For current F.1 students and repeaters of F.2
- Starts SBA (School Based Assessment) in SS1 contributing 15-20% marks
- Four core subjects (Eng, Chin, Math & Liberal Studies) plus Three electives.
 Capable students can take one more in future HK Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE).

Issue of Double Cohort



- University Intake in Sept 2012 remain at 18% of students?
- University ability to accommodate ~33% growth in teaching staff, space, etc.
- Two different courses, one for current SS students, one for NSS students at University?

Result: Intense competition to enter U. in the year 2012

Implication for WY F.2 students

- F.5 HKCEE in 2010 & F.7 AL 2012
 - No repeater offer in WYCHK
 - Repeaters have to find outside schools for entering the last HKCEE in 2011 & AL in 2013
- It is more beneficial to repeat before the SS1, if one have to:
 - Current F.2 students to NSS F.2 in 07-08, or
 F.3 students to NSS F.3 in 08-09

Study Matters

- More emphasis in studying while balancing other activities
- Pass in exam = Chin/Eng pass + half of other subjects
- Supplementary exam
 - Selected students to re-sit those subjects failed or attend special classes
 - Then consider promoting to next form in trial basis
- F3 streaming policy
 - Top 40 students allocated to 3K to improve student learning
 - Continue for one more year (07-08) and a review to be conducted
 - Dedicated teacher assigned for gifted programs for gifted students
- Split class arrangement
 - F1/2 has Eng/Chin divided to 28/14 students to enhance learning
 - F3 will have F3K no split class, F3W/Y/H grouped into 5 classes for Eng/Chin
